- Occupancy Policy: If you do travel with your family (which is NOT encouraged by NSI) you will have to stay at the student accommodation regardless.

















### Flights and Transportation

- Students can arrive via Porto or Lisbon International Airports
  - Francisco Sáo Carneiro Airport (OPO) is a 20minute drive
  - Lisbon International Airport (LIS) is a 3-hour train ride
- Students are responsible for getting to accommodations. For OPO to Porto, students can travel via metro, train, or car.
  - Metro: 40 minute metro ride to Trindade Station via the purple line, transfer to yellow line and ride two stops to São Bento station and then a 10 minute walk; cost: 1.3 EUR
  - 20 minute drive by Uber; cost: 20-25 EUR





# Finance: 2024 Summer Program Estimated Costs

*Tuition:* In-State: \$1,724.00; Out-of-State: \$2,856

*Non-Tuition Costs:* \$3,700 (Includes round-trip airfare, transportation to and from the airport, daily meals, and single-occupancy lodging.)
